

STUDENT STUDY

This is a very important area of operations. The Northam Residential College's position on study time is this:

We believe that it is every student's right to have adequate, uninterrupted time for daily study.

As staff we will not allow or permit any student's right to this critical time to be eroded by others.

. Study time is intended to provide the opportunity for homework/assignments, additional background reading/writing, revision and general reading. (The argument that one has finished ones homework or has no homework is simply not accepted as an excuse for poor homework habits).

. Years 8 and 9 students are to study in the dining room until identified as having appropriate study habits. They may then return to their rooms. Years 10 11 12 may study in their rooms, and MUST remain at their desk during the study period. Should they choose to ignore this procedure, they will be required to study in the dining room until they also display ongoing appropriate study habits.

. Request for help time (student-student assistance) during this time study time is discouraged.

. Request for extra study time after the study period needs to be arranged with a supervisor. Any student, who does not utilise the full two hour period, will not be given permission to study after lights out.

. Only one student per computer will be allowed. Bookings for computer use must be organised with the supervisor prior to the study period, and all computer booking close at 5pm daily, with the exception of early study whereby a cut off of 11am is to be observed. Internet access is for research material only. No email, hotmail or games access during study period under any circumstances. Maximum of one half an hour booking per student during scheduled study times.

. All tutoring sessions will be done in the dining room.

. Joint study/work for homework, projects, assignment or research is not permissible during study period.

. If a student returns late from any activity, or participates in sporting activities during the study period, they will be required to make up the full time study during their scheduled recreational time. Study time is not to be made up in split times, eg half and hour followed by half an hour.
